

The Three Heads & The Thinking Man

Three heads carved in one block of Limestone set upon a sandstone column with a capping stone between, reading the names of the three masters in Gaelic.

The figure represents the Fourth master , Michael Cleary , a monk whom thought of the idea to cronical the history of Ireland and brought together the three other men to research and compile the Annals of the Four Masters. He is carved from a single block of granite and rests upon a plinth made up of four sandstone blocks which represent the annals.
